Important Updates and Announcements for the Academic Year 2025 - 2026

As we prepare for the upcoming academic session, we would like to inform you of some important changes and updates.

1. House Allocation and Uniform Guidelines

- » Students will continue to belong to their respective houses: Blue, Green, Red, and Yellow.
- » Any student wishing to change their house must submit a formal application through their Class Teacher to the Principal. If approved, they will be required to purchase a new set of T-shirts from the Book Counter.
- » The school blazer and waistcoat must be Carbon Blue in colour. No other blazer colours will be permitted.
- The colour of the rest of the uniform remains unchanged. Uniform cloth is available at the school book depot.
- » Each student's house allocation is recorded in the School App for reference.

2. New School App - EduTinker

- We are introducing a new school app, EduTinker, to streamline communication and academic tracking.
- Once the app is fully operational, we will notify you via WhatsApp.
- We encourage all parents to actively use the app to stay updated on their ward's progress and school notifications.
- » All are encouraged to make the payment of fees through the App or use the QR Code for the payment of fees.

3. School Fees Structure

- The school fees for the academic year will be ₹800/- per month remains the same.
- The Re-Admission Fee remains ₹ 4500/- for Classes KG to X.
- » A Computer Fee of ₹ 750/- per annum applies to students from Class IV to X.
- The Re-Admission Fee for Class XII remains ₹ 12,000/-, as per the previous session.

4. Class XI & XII Updates

- The instalment system for Class XI and XII will remain unchanged.
- Students enrolled in the Science Stream will have monthly competitive examinations conducted at the school for all and coaching for those who are interested by paying additional fees.

5. Section Reallocation

» Students will be redistributed across sections to ensure balanced academic performance within each class.

Academic Session 2024-25: Results & Registration for 2025-26

We are pleased to share important information regarding the results of the current academic session and the registration process for the upcoming session. Kindly take note of the following details:

Final Examination Results & Registration

- Class Nursery, KG, and Class I to Class III: The final examination results will be distributed on 21 March 2025 (Friday) at 10:00 AM. Registration for the 2025-26 session will take place thereafter, with a fee of ₹800/- (April fees).
- » Class IV to Class XI: The final examination results will be distributed on 22 March 2025 (Saturday) at 10:00 AM. Registration for the 2025-26 session will take place thereafter, with a fee of ₹800/- (April fees).

Important Instructions

- Students must be accompanied by their parents or guardians to collect their results.
- The original Admit Card must be presented to the Class Teacher in order to receive the results.
- A special Assembly will be held at 10:00 AM, during which students securing First, Second, and Third positions in each class will be recognized. Additionally, students with 100% attendance will also be awarded.
- » All the fees will be paid in the fee counter

from this academic session onward.

Mandatory Registration

» Registration is compulsory for all students from Class Nursery to Class X who wish to continue their studies at St. Xavier's School, Harmutty.

School Office Closure

- » The School Office will remain closed from 23 March 2025 to 21 April 2025 (Monday).
- » No official work will be conducted during this period.

Admissions & Textbook Guidelines

» Due to full enrolment in classrooms, the school may not be accepting new admissions for Classes II to X and Class XII. Please refer to the school website for further updates.

- All students are required to purchase new textbooks and notebooks as per the revised curriculum.
- To maintain uniformity, the school will provide specially designed notebooks, and no other notebooks will be permitted.
